

**Minutes for the October 8, 2018 Cape Story by the Sea (CSBTS) General Meeting
at the Resort Conference Hotel submitted by Todd Solomon**

Meeting Start: Called to order at 7:32 pm by President Diana Albis. 14 attendees were present.

Special Presentation – Melia Trost of SMILE told us about her non-profit that helps provide goods and services to children with life threatening illnesses. She also told informed us of the Saturday December 1st 5k race that would take place through Cape Story along the Cape Henry Trail. The event will require all of the long streets to be closed to through traffic from 9am to 11am. Traffic monitors would be stationed on Kendall St to allow access for Cape Henry residents, but none planned for Cape Story. Members asked if monitors could be placed at one of Cape Story's long streets that have a Shore Drive median cut to allow at least one point of ingress/egress during the event.
